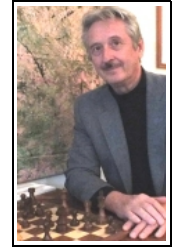


# Moran Prairie Elementary CHESS CLUB ~ Winter 2018 Grades 1-6

### INLAND CHESS ACADEMY'S PROGRAM

The Inland Chess Academy's curriculum is built on research proven methods developed by chess masters and educators, and recommended by the United States Chess Federation (USCF). **Beginner** - Beginners learn and demonstrate the basics of chess play, chess rules, and etiquette.
