Rounds 2-5 will begin within 10 minutes of the completion of the last game of the prior round.

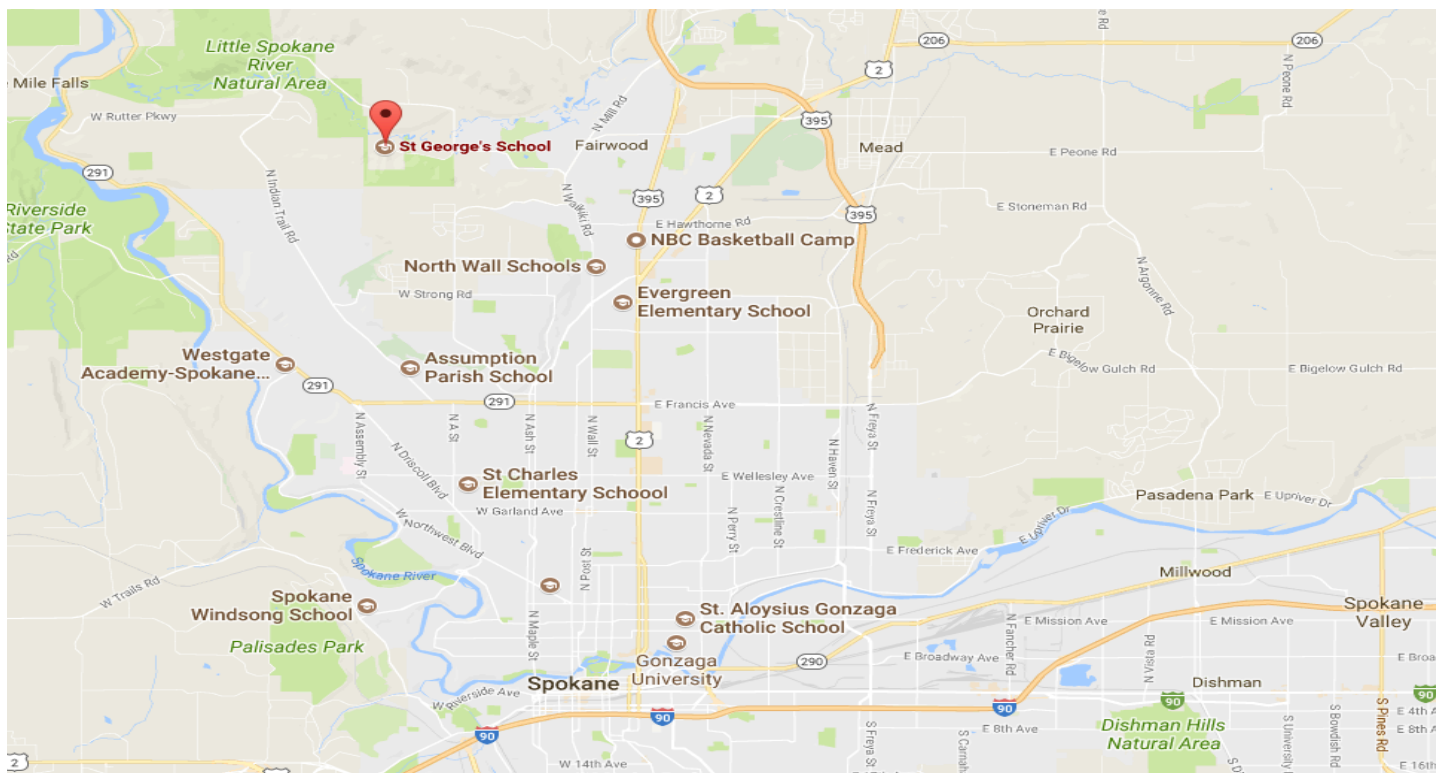
Awards ceremony immediately follows completion of the fifth game.

Three points (in one regional tournament) are required to qualify for the WA State Elementary Championship Tournament, April 21, 2018, Tri Cities.
