Inland Chess Academy is in need of chess coaches for before and after school chess clubs. Part time, earn \$35.00 for each one hour session.

Inland Chess Academy's School Program: School chess clubs meet once weekly before or after school for one hour. Inland Chess Academy coaches provide a 15 minute lecture/video/exercise and then direct 40 minutes of tournament style chess play. Autumn semester after school chess clubs are 6 to 10 weeks and winter/spring clubs are 8 to 12 weeks. The stipend for one hour chess club session is **\$35.00**. During the school year, on alternate Saturdays, Inland Chess Academy conducts regional WA State Championship qualifying chess tournaments. All students are encouraged to compete for individual and team awards. Coaches are offered opportunities to coach camps, study groups, and individual tutoring.

Certification to become an Inland Chess Academy Coach, requires:

- attend 18 to 25 hours of classroom training the time depends on your experience with children and knowledge of chess
- completion of online chess study course
- first-aid/CPR certification
- pass the USCF Club Tournament Director's examination
- pass Inland Chess exams
- various practicums and play in the coach's tournament

- subscriptions to Chess Magnet School
- United States Chess Federation membership
 - o after first year of coaching and after you have played your first USCF event
